**16/23/42/60 mile routes**

Enjoy a relaxing 16-mile tour along the river valley back roads between Whitehall and Independence. This is an easy ride for families or the occasional recreational bicyclist.

\*The 23-mile Loop follows the same route as the shorter loop but turns off at around the 10-mile point. This route soon begins a moderate yet steady climb to the Top of the World or at least seems like it. Square Bluff is the highest Trempealeau County road and one of the most spectacular panoramic views. Once on top of Square Bluff Road you will follow this ridge top for the next 4 miles. Be sure to take a few moments to enjoy the spectacular views while riding this ridge top road.

\*Extended "World Tours" Approximately 42 and 60 miles of challenging hills and spectacular views
